Bonjour, Paris!

On your fact sheet you should include the general information under the following headings:

1. EMPLACEMENT: Where is the monument located in Paris? On which street(s)? In which *arrondissement*?
2. HISTOIRE: When was it designed/built? /by whom? For what purpose? What is its historical significance?
3. USAGE ACTUEL: What is the modern day significance of this monument? What are its modern day uses? Does it serve the same purpose when it was originally built?
4. RÉACTION PERSONNELLE: Are there any interesting facts about this monument? What do you think about this monument? Why?

You will create a presentation (Powerpoint/Google Slides) in French and in English. You will speak to the class about your monument for at least 2 minutes per monument. **YOU MAY NOT READ FROM THE SLIDES.** There is a maximum 6 word per picture limit.

You must show at least 5 photos of your monument as well as the map of Paris indicating its location.

ASTUCE: Use Google maps to take a walking tour around your monument. Use the “Snipping Tool” to grab images.



In **French** you will need to include 5 facts about your monument. They may be repeated from your English presentation. Honors students must memorize their 5 facts.

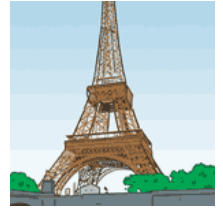

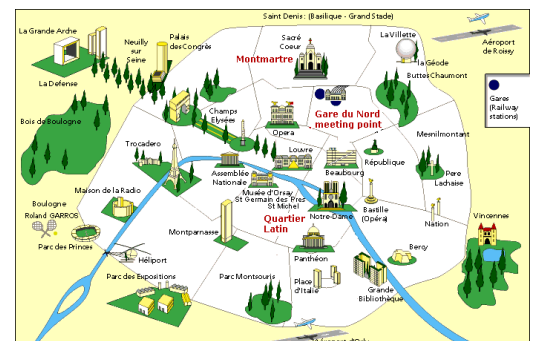


Bonjour, Paris! La Ville des Lumières
