- Minimum 100 words about your city. Use PowerPoint. Do not write more than 10 words on a slide. *or Slides*
- Using www.alitalia.com show how much it would cost to fly to your city at this time. (in Italian)
- Give information about what there is to do and see in your city. Include monuments and tourist attractions. You may wish to include information about any special celebrations or yearly traditions in the town.
- Give historical facts that you find interesting.
- Show a menu (in Italian) from a real restaurant from your city. Show a meal you would choose and how much it would cost.
- Show a hotel in your city. Show a room and how much it would cost to stay there for a night. (in Italian)
- Minimum of 10 photographs showing your city.
- A vocabulary list of at least 15 words that you have learned while doing your research
